Course Description:

This course surveys the history of the Christian Church from AD 1517 to the present day. We will examine major events, figures, and ideas that have shaped the church since the Reformation.

- Explain the key ideas that shaped the Church's development
- Demonstrate the ability to think critically about the history of the Church
